We are delighted to present the latest edition of our RIHP Hospital Newsletter. This edition highlights recent infrastructure improvements, diagnostic facility upgrades, healthcare services, community initiatives and the continued support received from our donors.

LATEST FACILITIES & INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADES

To meet the evolving healthcare needs of the community and further improve patient care and safety, the following developments have been undertaken:

- 160 KVA DG set installed to strengthen the hospital's power backup system and ensure uninterrupted essential services.
- Hospital plinth protection work completed to protect the hospital building from rainwater and moisture.
- Painting work was undertaken across the hospital premises.
- X-ray room renovation was completed to facilitate installation of the new Digital X-ray system
- Digital X-ray system from Fujifilm installed, further strengthening the hospital's diagnostic services.
- Continued infrastructure and safety improvements to provide a clean, safe and comfortable environment for patients, staff and visitors.

COMPREHENSIVE HEALTHCARE SERVICES

RIHP Hospital continues to provide a wide range of healthcare services to meet the needs of the surrounding rural community. Our services include General Medicine, General and Laparoscopic Surgery, Paediatric, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Orthopaedics, Nephrology, Urology, Cardiology, Ophthalmology, ENT, Dermatology, Dental Care and Physiotherapy.

Our dedicated team of doctors, nurses and paramedical staff strives to provide compassionate care and medical expertise at an affordable cost.

The hospital continues to strengthen its diagnostic services, including CT scan, Digital X-ray, Laboratory, USG, Echocardiography, ECG, Endoscopy and Pulmonary Function Test (PFT).

24/7 EMERGENCY & DIAGNOSTIC SERVICES

Our hospital provides 24/7 emergency services, with a dedicated team available to provide prompt and effective care during critical situations.

The availability of upgraded diagnostic facilities supports timely investigation and appropriate treatment for patients.

OUR TEAM

- 12 Specialist Doctors, including 6 in-house consultants, are offering regular care.
- Besides, our team consists of 22 qualified nurses, 3 Dialysis Technicians, 3 radiographers, 1 Physiotherapist and adequate paramedical staff.
- Currently the hospital has 59 employees that include paramedics and support staff.
- 48 beds to treat patients, wards as per need, 5 ICU beds and 5 PICU beds.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

RIHP Hospital continues to extend healthcare services beyond the hospital through medical camps and community outreach programmes.

Health screening and awareness activities were conducted for the benefit of people in rural, estate and underserved communities, with an emphasis on early detection, preventive healthcare and accessible treatment. A total of 9 outreach camps were conducted at both estate divisions and community levels, covering 777 beneficiaries. The camps included general health checkups as well as eye screening services. Total 10 cataract surgeries were performed, of which 2 were free of cost to camp beneficiaries

OUR PERFORMANCE (KEY INDICATORS)

From Jan to June 2026:

- 21,905 outpatients and 1,359 in patients were treated.
- 240 Major surgeries were performed
